ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-04

At a regular meeting of the Vergennes Township Board of Trustees held at the Vergennes Township Hall on August 16, 2021, 7:00 p.m., the following Ordinance to amend the Vergennes Township Zoning Ordinance was offered for adoption by Board Member Rasch and was seconded by Board Member Ford:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE VERGENNES TOWNSHIP ZONING
ORDINANCE; TO AMEND SECTION 201.402 PERTAINING TO
ACCESSORY BUILDINGS.

THE TOWNSHIP OF VERGENNES, COUNTY OF KENT, STATE OF MICHIGAN,
ORDAINS:

Section 1. Amendment of Section 201.402. Section 201.402. is amended to include a new subsection "G" which reads as follows:

- G. In the C-Commercial and I-Industrial zoning districts, shipping containers and similarly constructed storage structures may be permitted as an accessory structure, provided it meets the minimum setbacks for each zoning district and is properly screened by fencing, vegetation, or enclosed so as not to be visible from an adjacent street or residential property. All such structures will require zoning administrator approval before being placed on the property.

Section 2. Conflicts.

- A. If any provision of the Vergennes Township Ordinance conflicts with this amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, the terms of this amendment shall prevail.
- B. To the extent any provision of this ordinance may be preempted by state or federal law, then any such provision shall be enforced up to the fullest extent of any state or federal law before such preemption would occur.

Section 3. Miscellaneous, Severability. Should any section or part of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional, null or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not have any effect on the validity of the remaining sections or parts of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective seven (7) days after its publication, of a summary thereof, in a newspaper of general circulation in the Township.

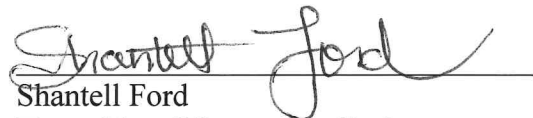
